Progress report of the TCG Working Group 2 on Capacity Development

The Working Group on Capacity Development (WG2) supports the SDG 4 Technical Cooperation Group (TCG) responding to the critical capacity development (CD) needs that may result from the implementation of the new agenda at national level. Indeed, monitoring SDG 4-Education 2030 will require using a wide range of data sources and will place considerable demands on countries to improve data quality in its different dimensions.

The main objectives of the WG2 is to contribute to the identification and better understanding of the statistical CD needs, provide guidance for feasible solutions and plans that can be disseminated to countries and other partners, and contribute to the harmonization of capacity development efforts.

An overview of the Working Group activities is provided below.

Summary of activities

At the TCG meeting held in Montreal (31 May-02 June 2017), the WG2 had agreed on the necessity to setup a statistical CD Framework that will help meeting the objectives assigned to the Group. The Framework should be mainly constituted of a Repository of CD Tools and a list of CD initiatives and Funding mechanisms. Such Framework would then be used to identify gaps in terms of CD areas and tools as well as funding mechanism to formulate responses to these gaps.

The activities of the WG between the meeting of June 2017 and January 2018 (TCG meeting in Dubai) were:

1. Designing the pilot Statistical CD Framework.
2. Developing a dedicated Wiki platform to host the CD Framework.

Since the TCG meeting in Dubai, the following activities were implemented:

1. Several improvements of the contents of the CD Framework were introduced in versions in both languages. The current version is available at the following link: <https://teams.unesco.org/cop/tcg/cd-en/SitePages/Statistical%20Capacity%20Development%20Framework.aspx>

2. Designing and implementation of a survey to evaluate the usefulness and areas to improve of the pilot Statistical Capacity Development Framework. The questionnaire was implemented between 15 October and 05 November and the results will be discussed and presented at the TCG meeting in Mexico.

The WG2 met in Montreal, May 2017, and agreed on the necessity to setup a **statistical CD Framework** which will help meeting these objectives.

The Framework is mainly constituted of a [Repository of CD Tools](#) and a list of [CD initiatives and Funding mechanisms](#). The overall statistical CD Framework is presented in a concept note at the [Resources](#) section here below.

Repository of CD Tools

The Framework is built on top of the UNDP generic five steps CD process grounded into the SDG4 Education 2030 context. It is elaborated through the identification (the inventory) of key education statistical areas where countries may require support (national education statistical capacity needs). The Framework will serve as a repository in which for each of these areas potential CD tools will be made available as public goods to help countries develop their statistical CD strategy or simply to pick some resources of interest when needed.

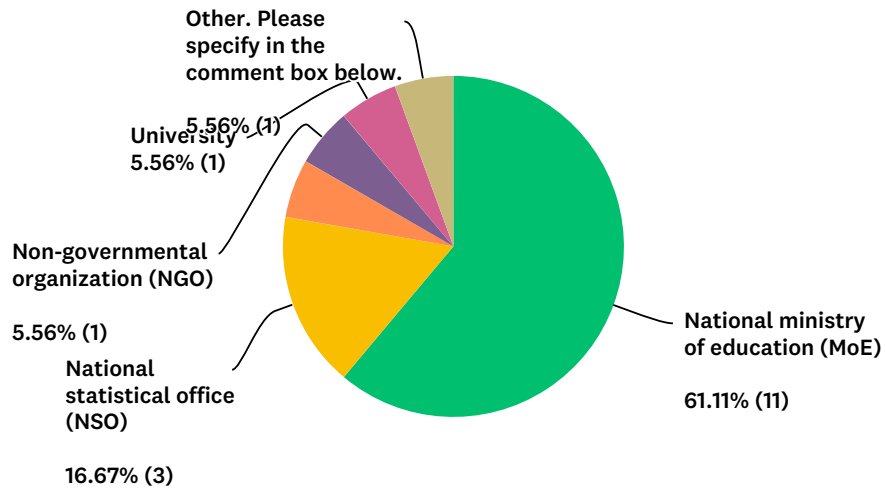

Answered: 18 Skipped: 2

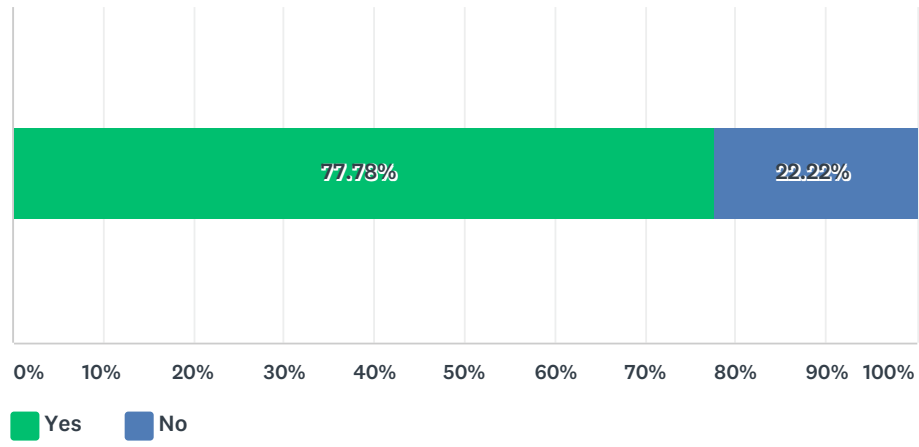


Q3 Please indicate your function (or position) in your organization and provide your email address

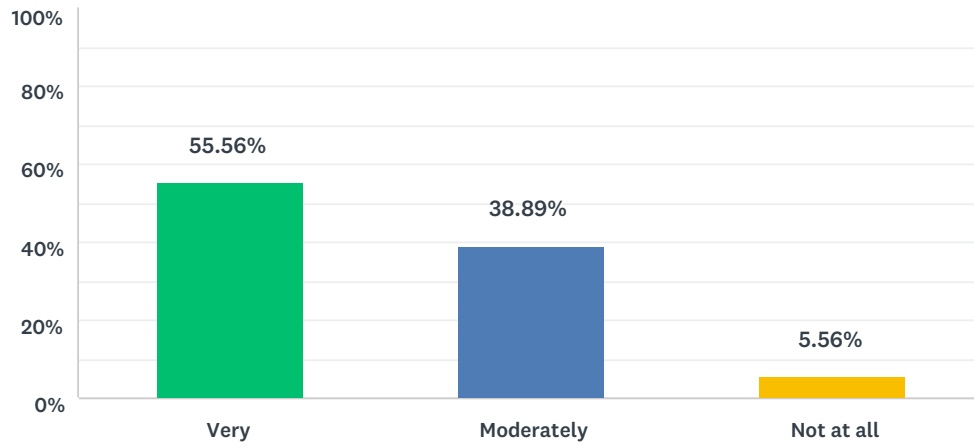
Q4 Have you ever participated in at least one of the previous meetings of the TCG?

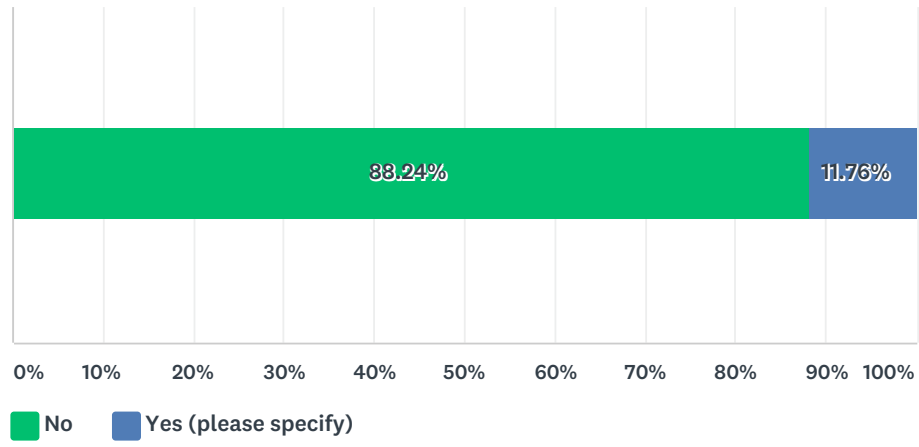
Q5 How is the repository of CD tools helpful in your view?

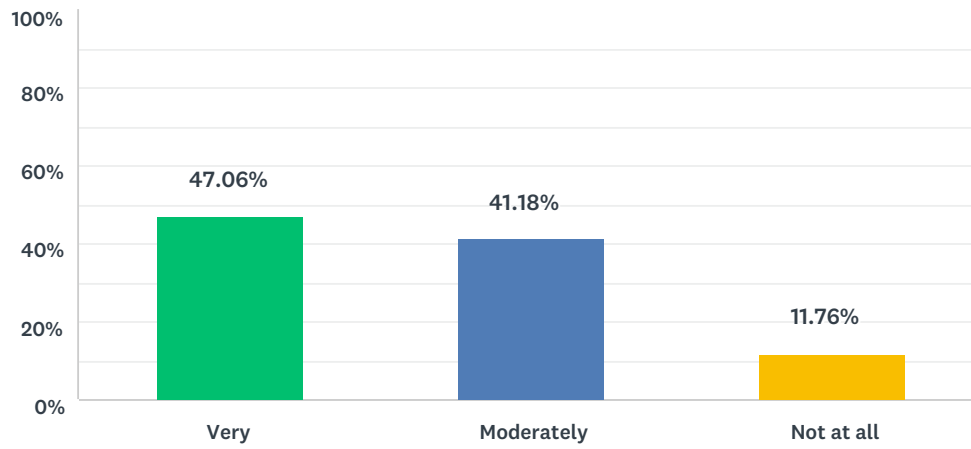


Q7 What would you suggest to improve the content of the repository of capacity development (CD) tools?
