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Inter-Agency Group on Education Inequality Indicators

- IAG-EII was established in 2016 to support production of SDG 4 indicators from household survey data
- Members: agencies working with household survey data
- Main output so far: indicator definitions
- TCG meeting is opportunity to start new activities



Existing indicator definitions

- 4.1.4. Completion rate (primary, lower secondary, upper secondary)
- 4.1.5. Out-of-school rate (primary, lower secondary, upper secondary)
- 4.1.6. Percentage of children over-age for grade (primary, lower secondary, upper secondary)
- 4.2.2: Adjusted net attendance rate in organized learning (one year before the official primary entry age)
- 4.2.4: Gross early childhood education attendance ratio in (a) pre-primary education, (b) early childhood educational development, and (c) early childhood education
- 4.3.2: Gross attendance ratio for tertiary education
- 4.5.1: Parity indices (female/male, rural/urban, bottom/top wealth quintiles and others such as disability status, indigenous peoples and conflictaffected, as data become available) for all education indicators on this list that can be disaggregated



Areas of work in 2019 and 2020

- Proposal: make IAG-EII a working group of the TCG
- Support development of sample survey-based SDG 4 indicators:
 - 4.1.4: completion rate
 - 4.3.1: participation rate of youth and adults in formal and non-formal education and training in the previous 12 months
 - 4.c.5: average teacher salary relative to other professions requiring a comparable level of education
- Maintain existing indicator definitions, add new definitions
- Contribute to harmonization of survey data used by different organizations
- Prepare guidelines for producers and users of survey data











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
