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EU framework

“Education and Training 2020”

is drawing to a close

the outgoing ET 2020:

- 1. Early school leaving (18-24)**
- 2. Tertiary attainment – 40%**
- 3. Early childhood education >3, 95%**
- 4. Underachievement in PISA**
- 5. Employment of graduates*
- 6. Adult learning*

European Education Area 2025:

- 1. Upper secondary completion**
- 2. Tertiary attainment**
- 3. Early childhood education**
- 4. Underachievement in PISA**
- 5. Underachievement in digital competence**

meaning that...

1. Upper secondary completion 20-24
2. Tertiary educational attainment – 50%
3. Early childhood education – age from 4 down to 3, 98%
4. PISA – unchanged
5. Underachievement in digital competence (ICILS by IEA)

monitoring areas

1. Learning mobility

2. multilingualism

3. Employment of graduates

4. VET Adult learning

process

- **Commission services identified 12 “benchmarkable areas”**
- **Twelve expert groups with Member States**
- **A technical proposal by the Commission**
