TCG 9 decision: International conference on education statistics

Organize first 3-day international conference on education statistics

With the following objectives:

- reflect on experience and lessons of SDG 4 benchmarking process
- promote common understanding of recent methodological developments
- reach broader constituency and capture Member State needs and demands
- provide opportunity to the community of practice to meet
- identify potential process improvements
- discuss future agenda

6 February	Pre-conference Engagement Day	Focused discussion on life-long learning dimensions coordinated by ED and partners.
7 – 8 February	Current challenges and proposed solutions for existing SDG indicators	Position papers were consulted with Member States and regional partners (October/November): focused on methodological and coverage challenges.
9 February	Partnerships and coordination of statistical and data systems and role of technology	 Collaboration with sister agencies (ILO, WHO, ITU, WFP, UNICEF) and cooperation at regional level Opportunities and challenges of technology


