When	Established by UIS/Global Education Monitoring Report (GEMR) in May 2016	Established by UNSC in March 2015
Mandate	To lead development of thematic indicator framework involving subject experts, countries, civil society and partner organizations	To lead development of the global indicator framework
Indicator framework endorsed	ED 2030 Steering Committee (SC) in December 2016 (thematic framework)	Formally adopted by Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC) in June 2017 and later by the UN General Assembly (UNGA) in July 2017 (Global framework)
Reports to coordination/governance body	 ED 2030 SC from 2016 and 2022 SDG4-Education 2030 High-Level Steering Committee (HLSC) since 2022 	Coordination and Management meeting of ECOSOC adopted resolution noting UNSC's report (June 2016)



Description	Adopt the proposed Rules of procedure.	Do not adopt the proposed Rules of procedure.
Pros	Ensures that the organization, roles and responsibilities are clear to everybody and help to strengthen the functioning of any body	-
Cons	If too detailed could be a heavy burden.	Favors misunderstanding and inefficiencies that could lead to conflict.
