Upper Primary	9 – 12	Placement	National and Regional
Lower Secondary	13 – 15	Diagnostic/Placement	School-based, National
Upper Secondary	16 – 18	Placement, Transition	National and Regional

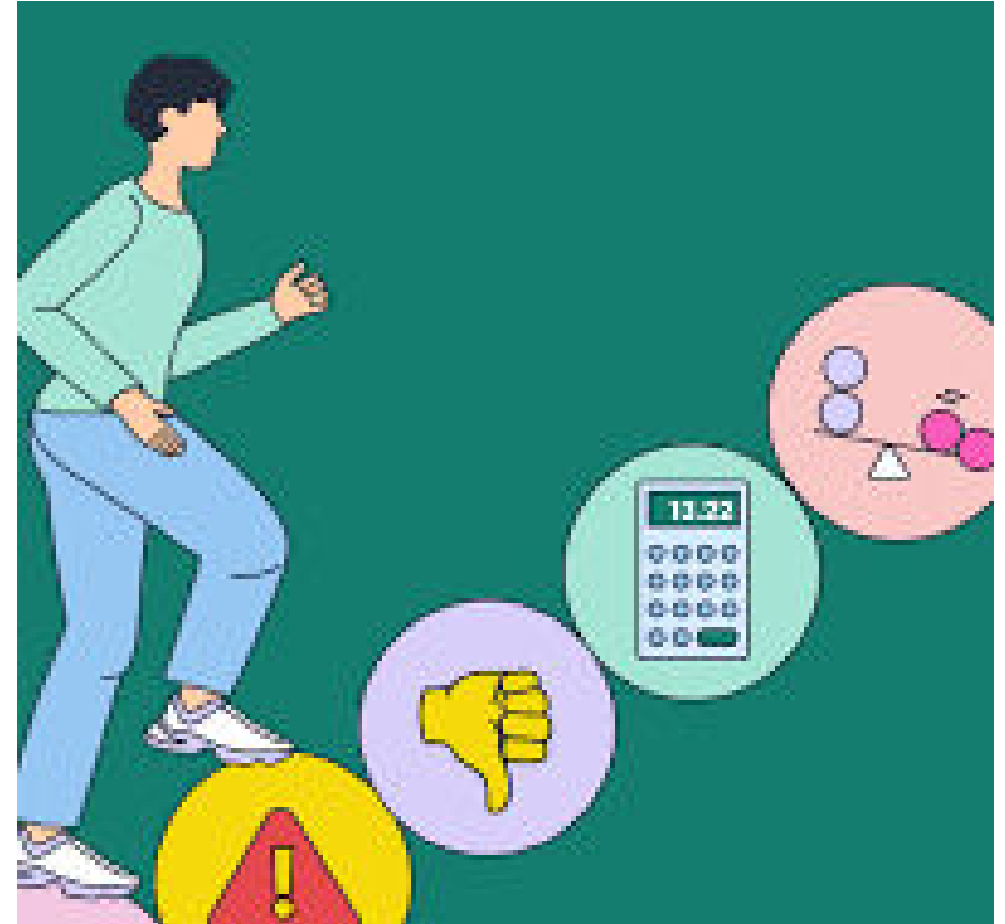
